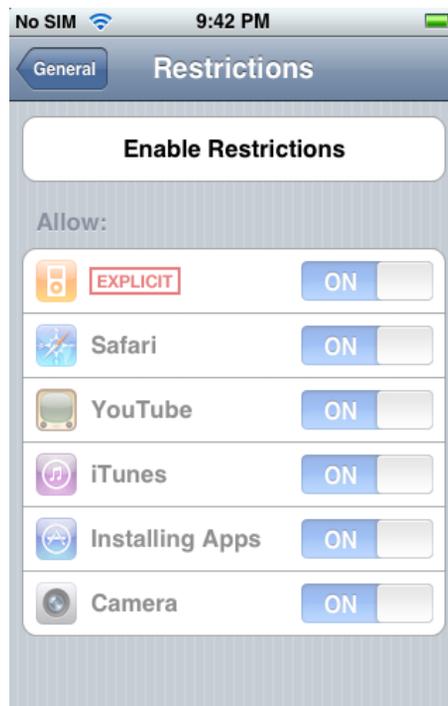


IPHONE AND IPAD SAFETY FEATURES

If owning an Apple iPhone or iPad is in your child's future, here are some safety features you should know. By going into the **Settings** app and choosing **General**, you can click on **Enable Restrictions**. This will then prompt you to create a four digit code that you will need to know when making future changes. **Make sure you write this code down because you will not be able to access restrictions in the future without it and it is big pain to retrieve it once lost.**

Once you have done that you can turn off the apps you do not want your child having access to.



Things to Note:

These restrictions are only helpful if your child is the sole user of the device. You won't be able to set certain restrictions for certain users.

There is no way to restrict your web browser other than turning it off completely. You can download safe search apps from iTunes store that filters searches automatically.

Your child can still download apps that you may not approve of. The only way to prevent it is to turn off the app store and/or restrict apps to download by age requirement. See iTunes Parental Control to learn how to do this.
